The Wenlock Olympian Gliding Games is a bi-annual event organised by Midland Gliding Club in partnership with the Wenlock Olympian Society. It is the only gliding event in the UK that awards Olympian Gliding medals.



For those that wish it is a serious gliding competition with a single handicapped open class for all wood and fabric covered gliders. There are (small and inexpensive) prizes for the day winners and Gold, Silver and Bronze Olympian Society medals for the top three competing pilots. Met. briefings and task setting available for all on every flyable day.



For those that don't it is a chance to fly in some of England and Wales' best countryside, largely unhindered by airspace in the company of like minded vintage enthusiasts from across Europe. Local thermal, ridge and wave conditions allow flying most of the time from the UK's highest gliding club with the added advantage of professional winch launches to around 3000' asl and bungee launching in suitable conditions.



The club offers comfortable private accommodation, bunk rooms, caravan parking and camping, professional catering and a well stocked bar. The local area offers a wealth of things to do for non-flying family especially walking and cycling. Children of all ages are especially welcome.
